

Miramar National Cemetery Support Foundation

The Miramar National Cemetery Support Foundation was formed in 2006 to advocate for a new cemetery to augment the historic Fort Rosecrans National Cemetery. The effort was successful, and Miramar National Cemetery was dedicated in November 2010.

The Foundation's mission is, "To support the activities of the Miramar National Cemetery by advising on specific memorial projects, raising funds to construct those projects, administering memorial trust funds, and sponsoring honors ceremonies to mark significant patriotic events throughout the year."

The Foundation focuses on enhancing the cemetery with such features as the unique Avenue of Flags, the POW monument, and others on the Memorial Walkway honoring veterans' organizations.

The Foundation's current project is a Veterans Tribute Carillon and Bell Tower. It is supported by a major contribution from a prominent local veteran, and by donations from the public.
